## Simple Crochet Patterns for Baby Items

### Baby Blanket

- 5mm crochet hook

Instructions:

1. Create a slip knot and chain 120 stitches.
2. Row 1: Single crochet in each chain stitch across (120 sc).
3. Row 2-100: Repeat Row 1.
4. Finish off and weave in loose ends.

### Baby Hat

## Materials:

- Worsted weight baby yarn, approximately 200 yards
- 4.5mm crochet hook

## Instructions:

1. Create a slip knot and chain 4, join in a ring with a slip stitch.
2. Row 1: Single crochet 6 times into the ring (6 sc).
3. Row 2: Double crochet in each stitch around (6 dc).
4. Row 3-12: Alternate 1 single crochet and 1 double crochet in each stitch around (12 sc/12 dc).
5. Row 13-15: Single crochet in each stitch around (30 sc).
6. Finish off and weave in loose ends.

## **Baby Socks**

### Materials:

- Baby sock yarn, approximately 50 yards
- 3.5mm crochet hook

### Instructions:

1. Create a slip knot and chain 15 stitches.
2. Row 1: Single crochet in each chain stitch across (15 sc).
3. Row 2: Increase by single crocheting twice in each stitch (30 sc).

4. Row 3-12: Single crochet in each stitch around (30 sc).
5. Fold the fabric in half and join the sides with single crochet (15 sc).
6. Create a cuff by chaining 20 stitches and single crocheting along one side of the opening.
7. Finish off and weave in loose ends.
