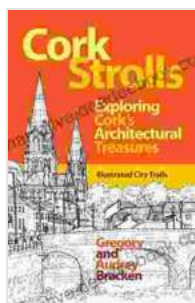

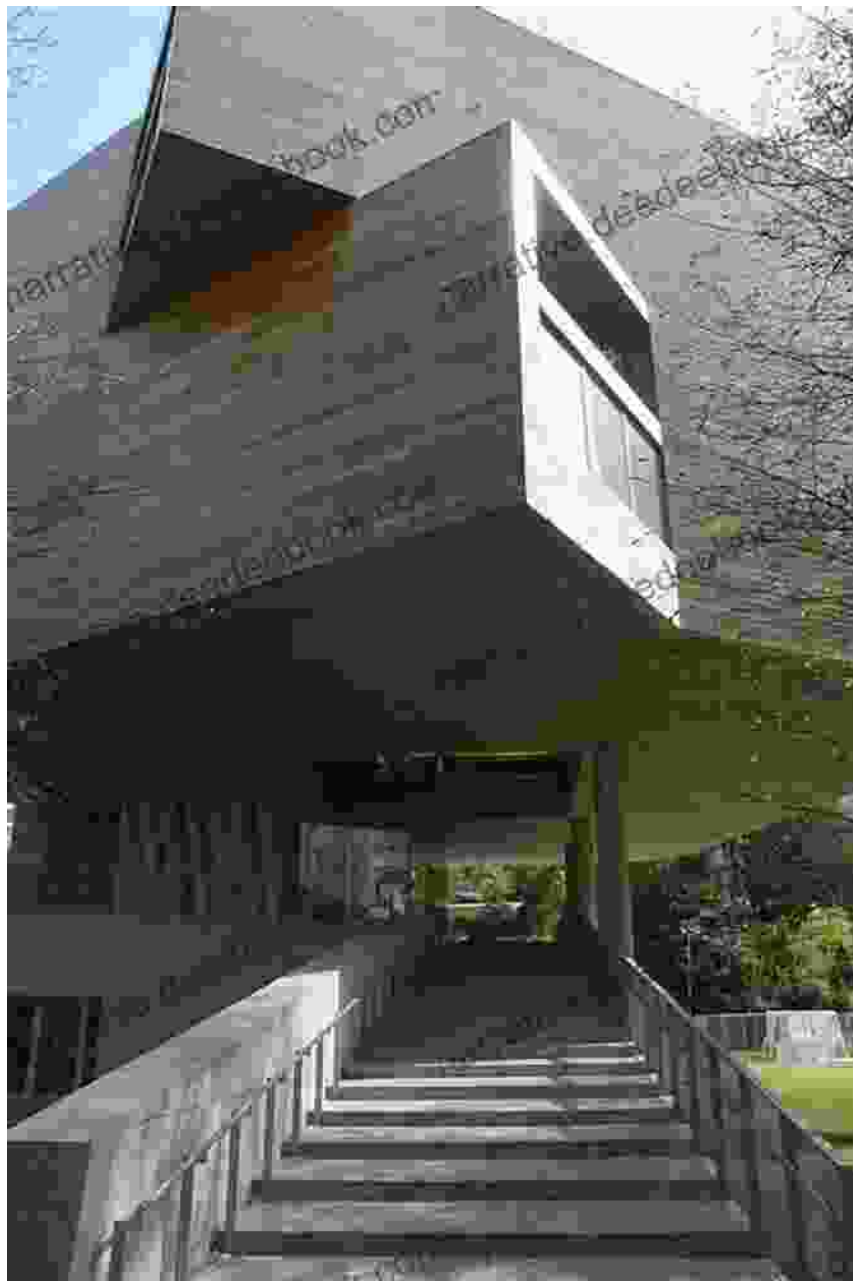


St. Fin Barre's Cathedral

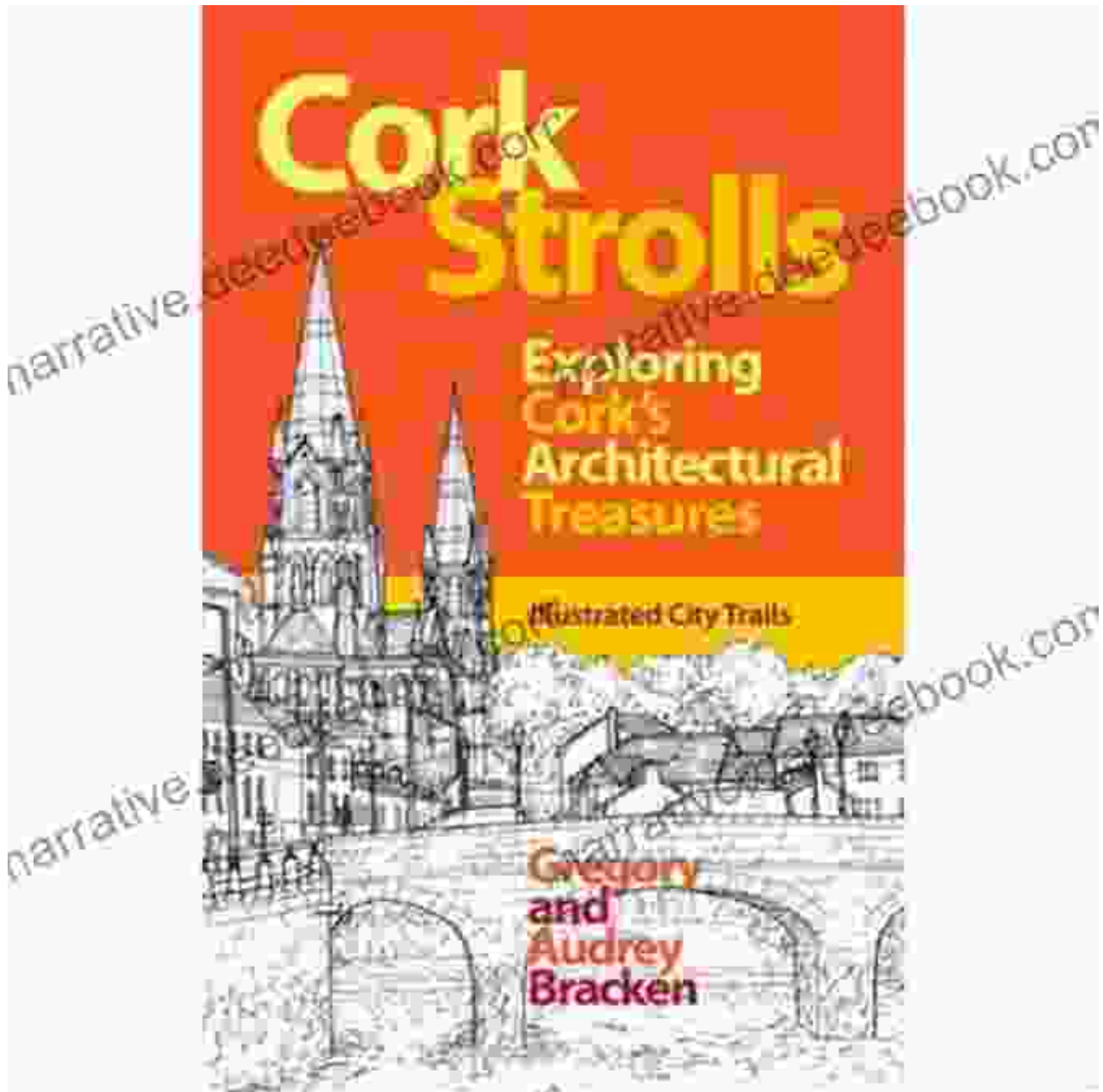
The Glucksman Gallery

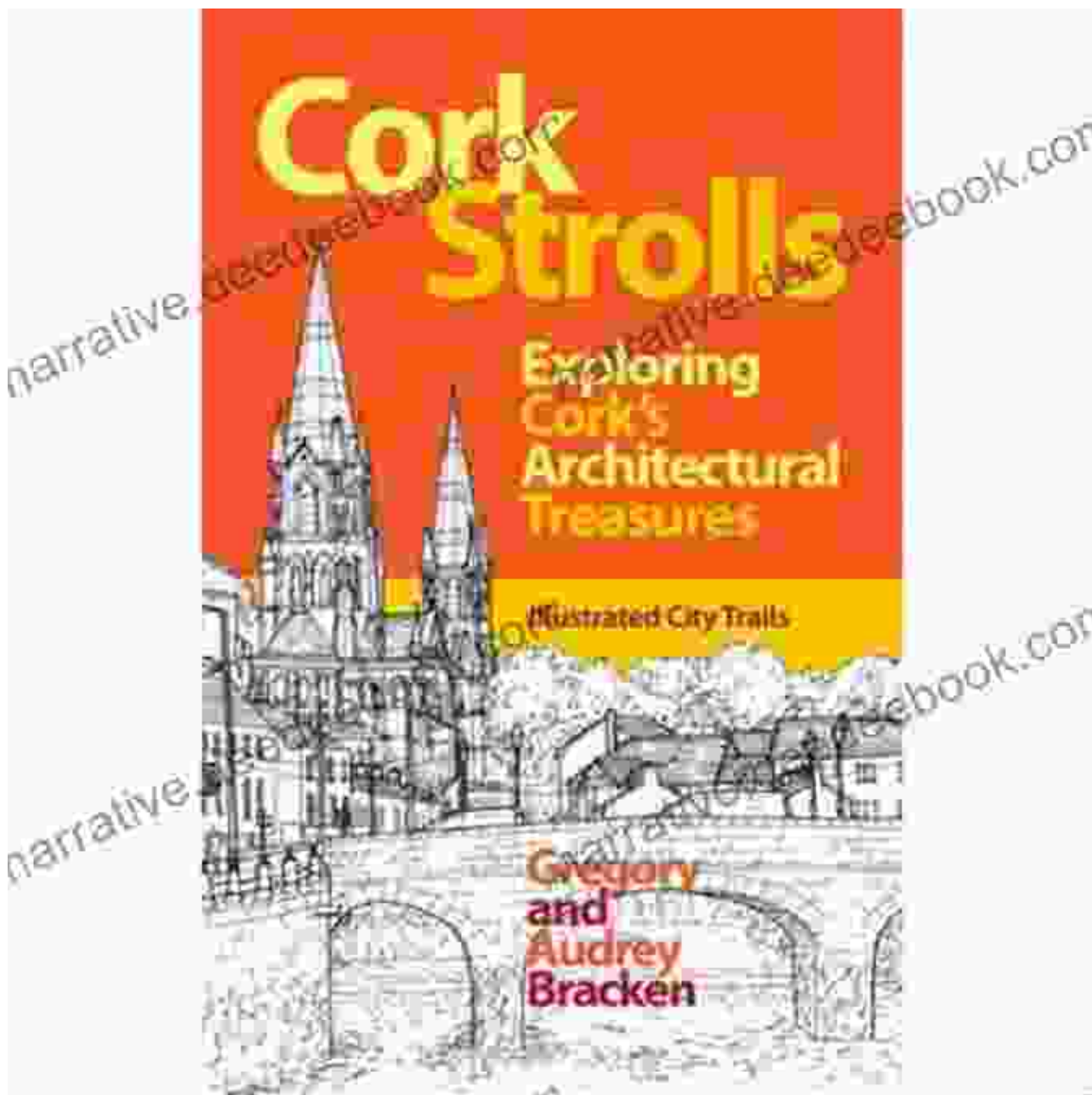
Cork City Hall

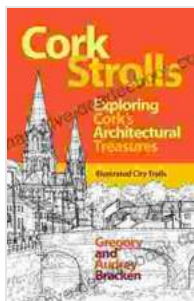
Holy Trinity Church
