1. Chain 100 (or any desired width)

Lending

2. Row 1: Single crochet in each chain across.

3. Repeat Row 2 for desired length or width.

4. To create the lace border: Row 1: Chain 3, skip 3 stitches, single

crochet in next stitch; repeat from * to *.

5. Row 2: Chain 2, skip 2 chains, single crochet in next chain space,

chain 3, skip 2 chains, single crochet in next chain space, single

crochet in next stitch; repeat from * to *.

Materials: Super bulky weight yarn, crochet hook size M (9mm)

Instructions:

1. Crochet a rectangle using any preferred stitch pattern.

2. For the hood: Chain 20 for the border. Join with a single crochet to

form a circle.

3. Work in rounds, increasing 6 stitches per round for 4 rounds.

4. Sew the hood to one end of the rectangle.

Materials: Worsted weight yarn, crochet hook size G (4mm)

Instructions:

1. Chain 4, join to form a ring.

2. Round 1: Single crochet in the ring 12 times.

3. Round 2: Single crochet in the first stitch, 2 single crochet in the next

stitch; repeat from * to *.

4. Repeat Round 3 for desired length.

5. To make the pompom: Wind the yarn around a fork, cut, and tie securely. Attach to the top of the hat.

Materials: Chunky weight yarn, crochet hook size I (5.5mm)

Instructions:

- 1. Chain 15, single crochet in the 4th chain from the hook and in the remaining chains across.
- 2. Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch across, turning at the end of the row.
- 3. Repeat Row 2 for desired width of the hat.
- 4. Fold the hat in half and sew the bottom edges together.
- 5. To create the ear flaps: Chain 15, single crochet in the 7th chain and in the remaining chains across. Repeat for the other flap.

Materials: Worsted weight yarn, crochet hook size G (4mm)

Instructions:

- 1. Chain 15, single crochet in the 5th chain from the hook and in the remaining chains across.
- 2. Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch across, turning at the end of the row.
- 3. Repeat Row 2 for 10 rows.
- 4. Chain 10, turn, and single crochet back across the chain.

- 5. Sew the ends of the chain to the top of the bootie to form the strap.
- 6. Sew on a button for decoration.

Materials: Cotton thread weight yarn, crochet hook size C (2.75mm)

Instructions:

- 1. Chain 20, join to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Single crochet in the ring 12 times.
- 3. Round 2: Single crochet in the first stitch, 2 single crochet in the next stitch; repeat from * to *.
- 4. Repeat Round 3 for desired length.
- 5. To create the lace-up holes: Skip 2 stitches, single crochet in the next stitch, chain 3, skip 2 stitches, single crochet in the next stitch. Repeat along the edge.
- 6. Cut 2 pieces of lace or ribbon for the laces and thread them through the holes.

Materials: Worsted weight yarn, crochet hook size G (4mm) for the body, and E (3.5mm) for the details

Instructions:

- 1. **Head:** Chain 6, join to form a ring. Round 1: Single crochet 6 times in the ring. Round 2-6: Single crochet in each stitch around.
- 2. **Body:** Chain 14, join with a slip stitch to form a circle. Round 1: Single crochet in each chain around. Rounds 2-10: Single crochet in each

stitch around.

- 3. **Legs:** Chain 10, single crochet in the 2nd chain from the hook and in the remaining chains across. Row 2-5: Single crochet in each stitch across.
- 4. **Arms:** Chain 8, single crochet in the 2nd chain from the hook and in the remaining chains across. Row 2-4: Single crochet in each stitch across.
- 5. **Ears:** Chain 6, single crochet in the 2nd chain from the hook and in the remaining chains across. Row 2-3: Single crochet in each stitch across.
- 6. Assemble the teddy bear by sewing the pieces together.

Materials: Soft worsted weight yarn, crochet hook size G (4mm)

Instructions:

- 1. Chain 6, join to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Single crochet in the ring 12 times.
- 3. Rounds 2-10: Single crochet in each stitch around.
- 4. Fill the rattle with a small amount of stuffing.


