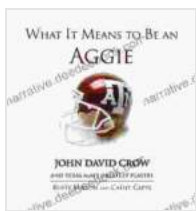


John David Crow and the Greatest Players in Texas Longhorns History

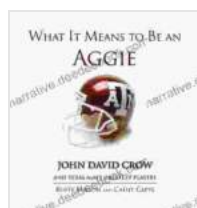
