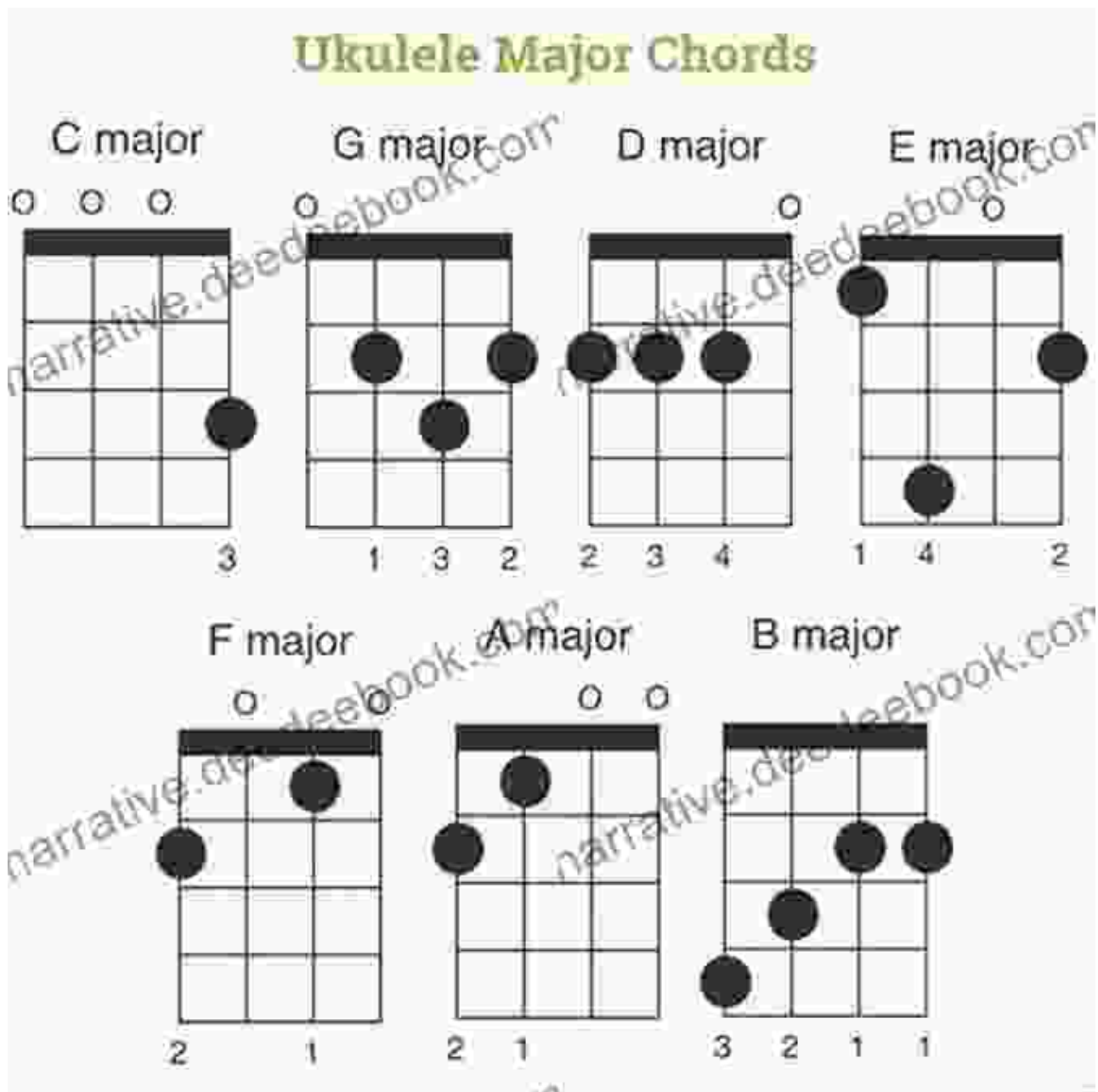

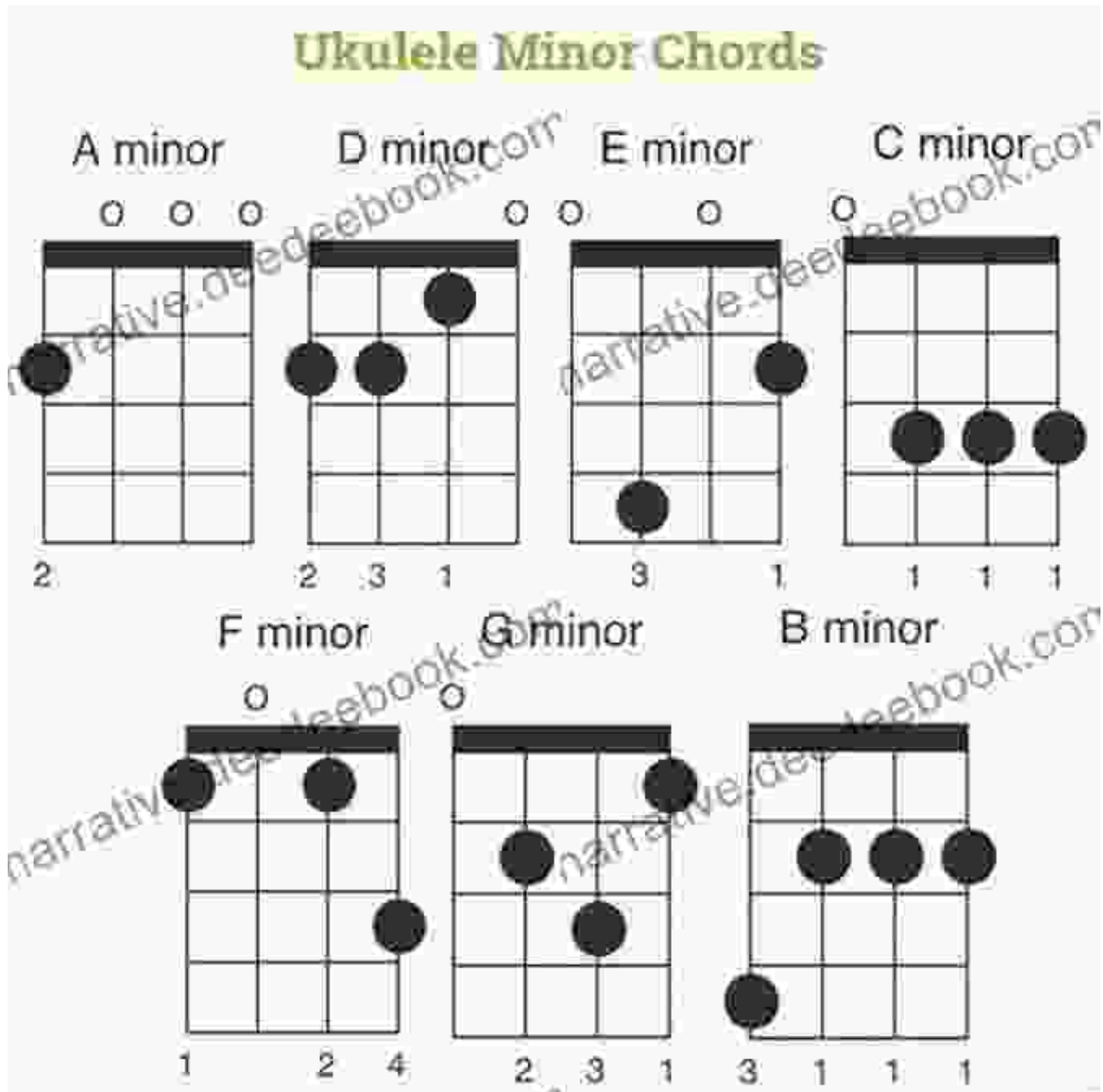

- Middle finger on the third fret of the fourth string

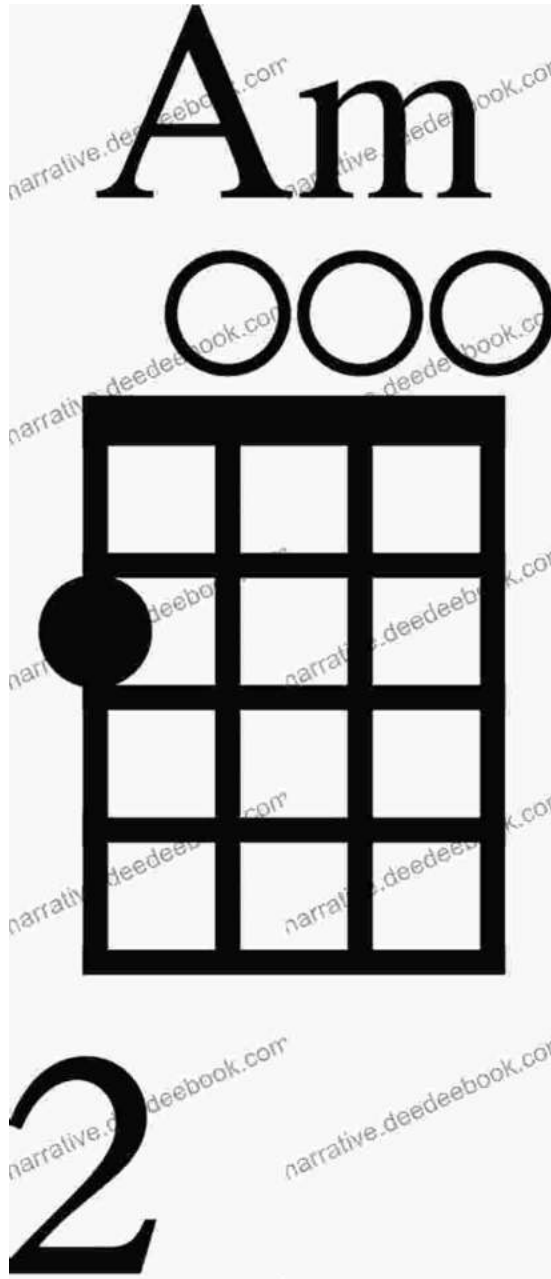
D Minor

Am (A Minor)



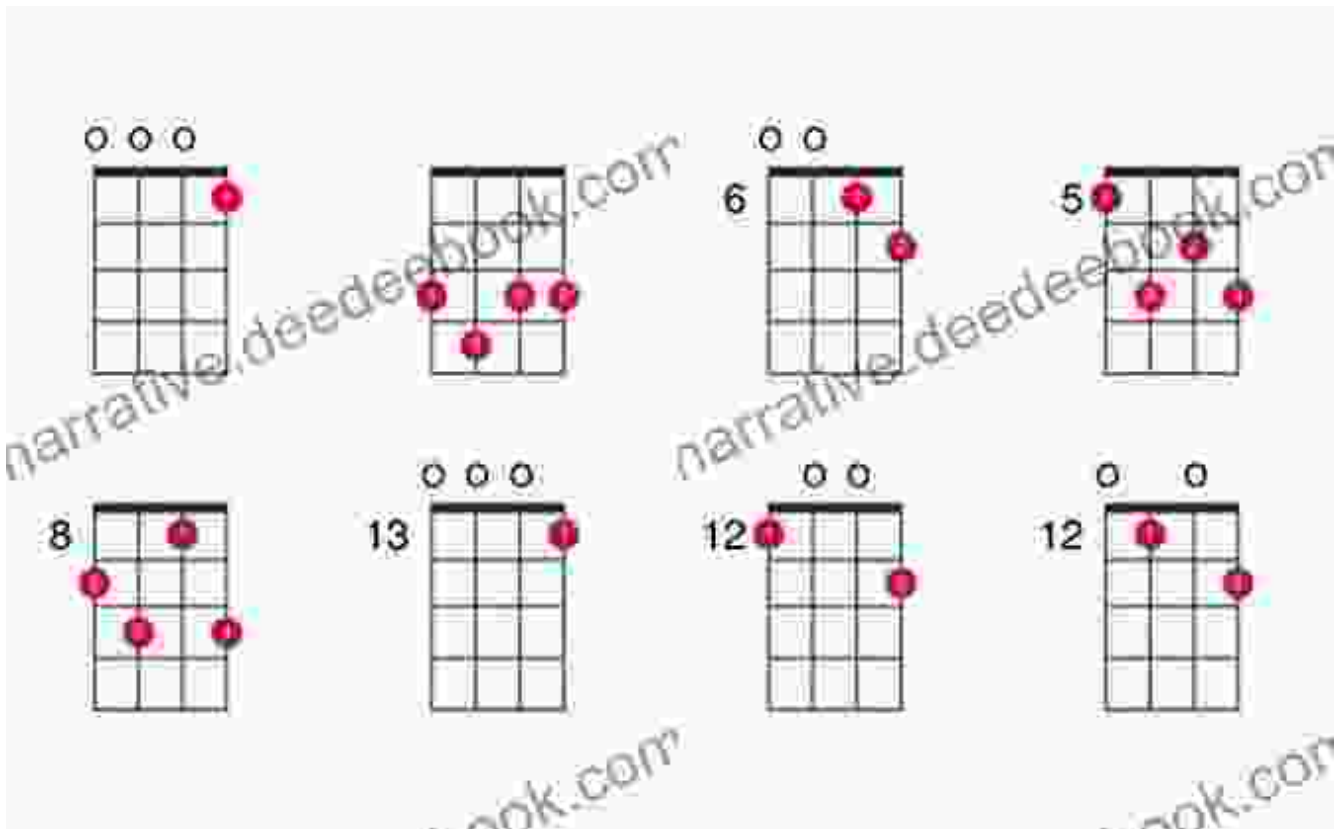
Finger Placement:

C7 (C Dominant Seventh)

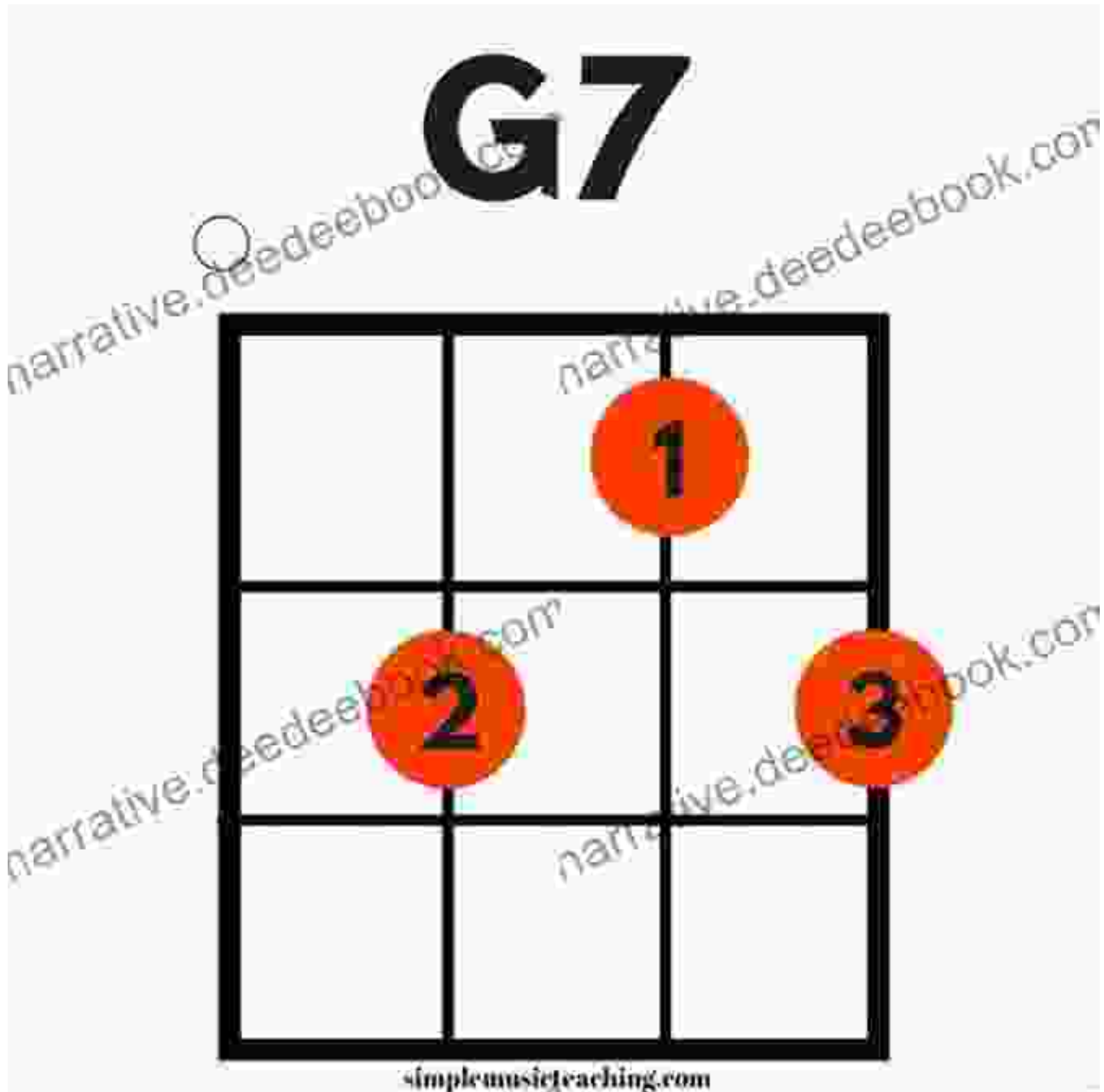


Finger Placement:

- Ring finger on the third fret of the fourth string

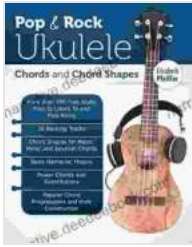
