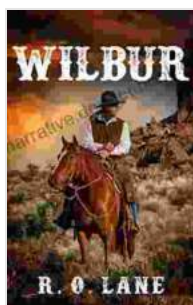


Wilbur Lane: A Legendary Figure in the World of Jazz

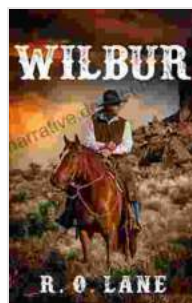
Later Years and Legacy
